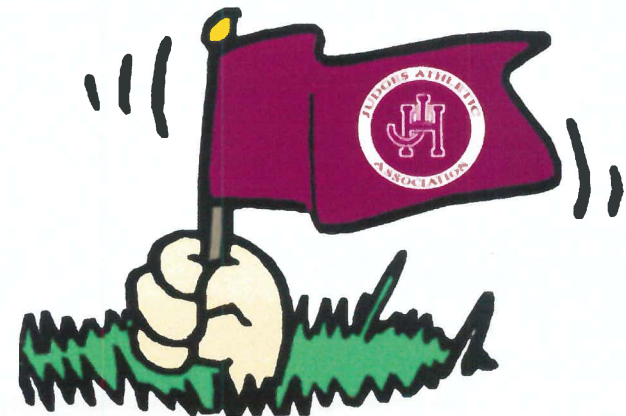

To provide scholarships for deserving student athletes and to provide funds for the purchase of equipment for the athletic programs.



Founded in 1957 with 40 active members, the Judges Athletic Association provides support to the athletic program at John Handley High School and to the participating student athletes. The association is governed by a board of directors selected from the general membership and is completely independent of Handley's athletic administration. The JAA has two main functions: to provide funds for the purchase of equipment for the athletes that the school could not provide and to provide scholarships for deserving student athletes.

The JAA scholarship program uses the major portion of the funds raised. Since the JAA's founding, the scholarships have provided deserving student athletes with more than \$2,000,000 in assistance toward the cost of their college educations. Any student who has participated in the school athletic program, including cheerleaders and managers, is eligible. The scholarships are awarded primarily on financial need, academic success and athletic participation.

The athletic department at JHHS is the second major beneficiary of the efforts of the JAA. Major gifts to the school have included a Bluebird activity bus and a van for traveling to away games. The JAA also provided \$50,000 to fund equipment for the new "Larry Nelson Memorial Fitness Room." During the 2018-2019 school year the JAA has committed approximately \$19,000 to the athletic department to purchase needed uniforms and other athletic needs.
